IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. A refundable room deposit is required for all students. This is paid in your first year.
2. **CHECK IN DATE** for New/First Year residents is between 10.00am-2.00pm on Saturday 20 February 2021.
CHECK IN DATE date for Returning Residents is after 2.00pm on Friday 26 February 2021.
3. Residents must depart College by 10:00am on check-out date unless prior arrangements have been made with the Office.
4. Fees are to be paid in full by the due dates, unless a direct debit plan is in place, otherwise an administration fee is charged. Penalties apply to outstanding amounts at the end of each Trimester.
5. Discounts for yearly and half-yearly payments apply to the accommodation fee component only, not to the levies or refundable deposits.
6. Fees may be reviewed for the second half of the year.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

For February-June billing, an invoice will be sent prior to the commencement of residency, once the Accommodation Agreement is accepted and the Fee Agreement and payment of deposit are received (\$1,000 deposit for new residents and \$800 deposit for returning residents). The amount of the deposit is applied against deposits and levies, with the balance applied as a credit against fees. An invoice for the accommodation fees for each billing period will be emailed prior to the billing period. Outstanding fee reminders are given to residents prior to the end of each fee payment period.

It is important that all fees are paid on time. If you are experiencing difficulties in paying your fees, the College will endeavour to assist you. It is important that you notify the College Office if you are encountering any difficulties in paying your fees.

The University Financial Directorate has strict guidelines with regard to payment of fees. Failure to pay your fees may result in:

- your residency at the College being terminated,
- penalties,
- delays in enrolling or withholding of an enrolment in your course,
- inability to graduate
- suspension of library privileges; or
- debt collection referral.
